When you come to Roppongi, a traditional Japanese- festival " Torinoichi" will be held in Azabu Juban next to Roppongi.

The *Tori-no Ichi* festival is held on the days of the rooster (one of the 12 signs of the zodiac) in November at shrines throughout Japan to celebrate the harvest and pray for luck and business prosperity.

The *Kumade* (rakes usually made of bamboo), which symbolize collecting luck and good fortune, will be sold at street stalls.

In addition, various stall vendors line the shopping street, creating a lively atmosphere
